Definitions:

Persistence: A student remains enrolled until completion of a certificate or degree

Full-Time: More than 12 credits per academic term

First-Time: Student enrolling at SKC for the first time

First Generation College Student: Neither of the student's parents (or guardians) have completed a Bachelor degree

American Indian: Enrolled Tribal Members or First- or Second- Generation Descendants of Tribal Members
