### Definitions:

Persistence:	A student remains enrolled until completion of a certificate or degree
Full-Time:	Enrolled for 12 or more credits per academic term
First-Time:	Student enrolling at SKC for the first time
First Generation College Student:	Neither of the student's parents (or guardians) have completed a Bachelor degree
American Indian:	Enrolled Tribal Members or First- or Second- Generation Descendants of Tribal Members
Persistence:	A student remains enrolled until meeting the student's educational goal.
